Water Management Data Specialist (Application Developer)

The Upper Thames River Conservation Authority is currently accepting resumes for a Water Management Data Specialist – Application Developer (WMDS-AD) position. This short fixed-term contract position will be up to 12 months in length.

Responsibilities:

The primary responsibilities of the WMDS-AD are maintaining and further developing existing web-based reporting applications in collaboration with water management subject matter experts within the UTRCA. This will include web-based tools to support WISKI database users and development, using REST-API, and/or kiWIS, a Web-based interoperability solution provided by Kisters. The WMDS-AD will participate in an innovative water management data modelling exercise and the development of applications to support UTRCA analysis needs related to time series monitoring data.

- Three years post secondary education in Computer Science or related discipline.
- 1 – 3 years experience working with client and server side web development, experience using PHP, Java Script, Python, Visual Studio.NET etc...
- Excellent knowledge and demonstrated experience programming web-based applications, general coding conventions, source control, and technical documentation.
