The Issue:

- Larger and more frequent storms
- Too much water and too many pollutants entering our waterways



When is Stormwater a Problem?

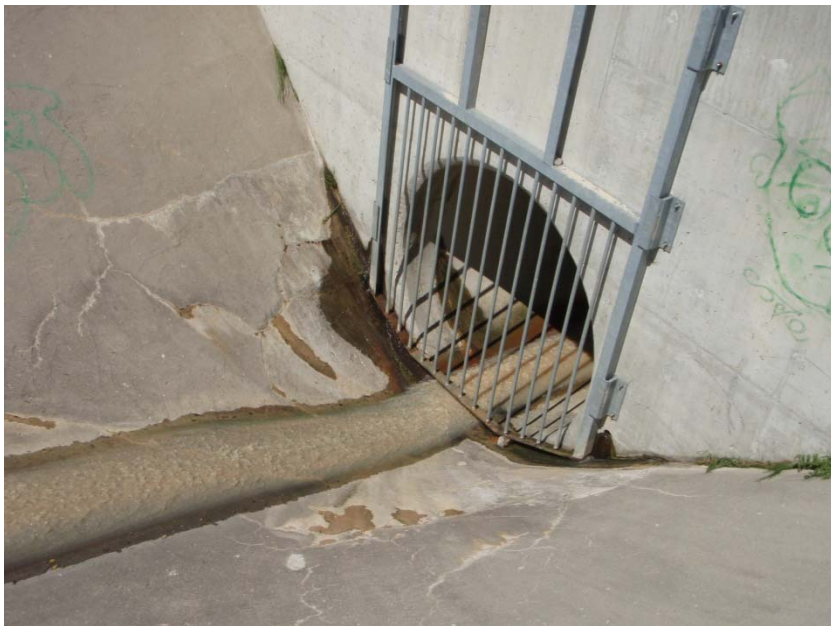
- Urban stormwater can cause flooding and water quality problems
 - Hard/impervious surfaces - rooftops, parking lots, roads and driveways - water can't soak in





When is Stormwater a Problem?

- Stormwater can carry pollutants into storm drains, which takes them directly into our creeks, the Thames River and, eventually, to Lake Erie

where it falls

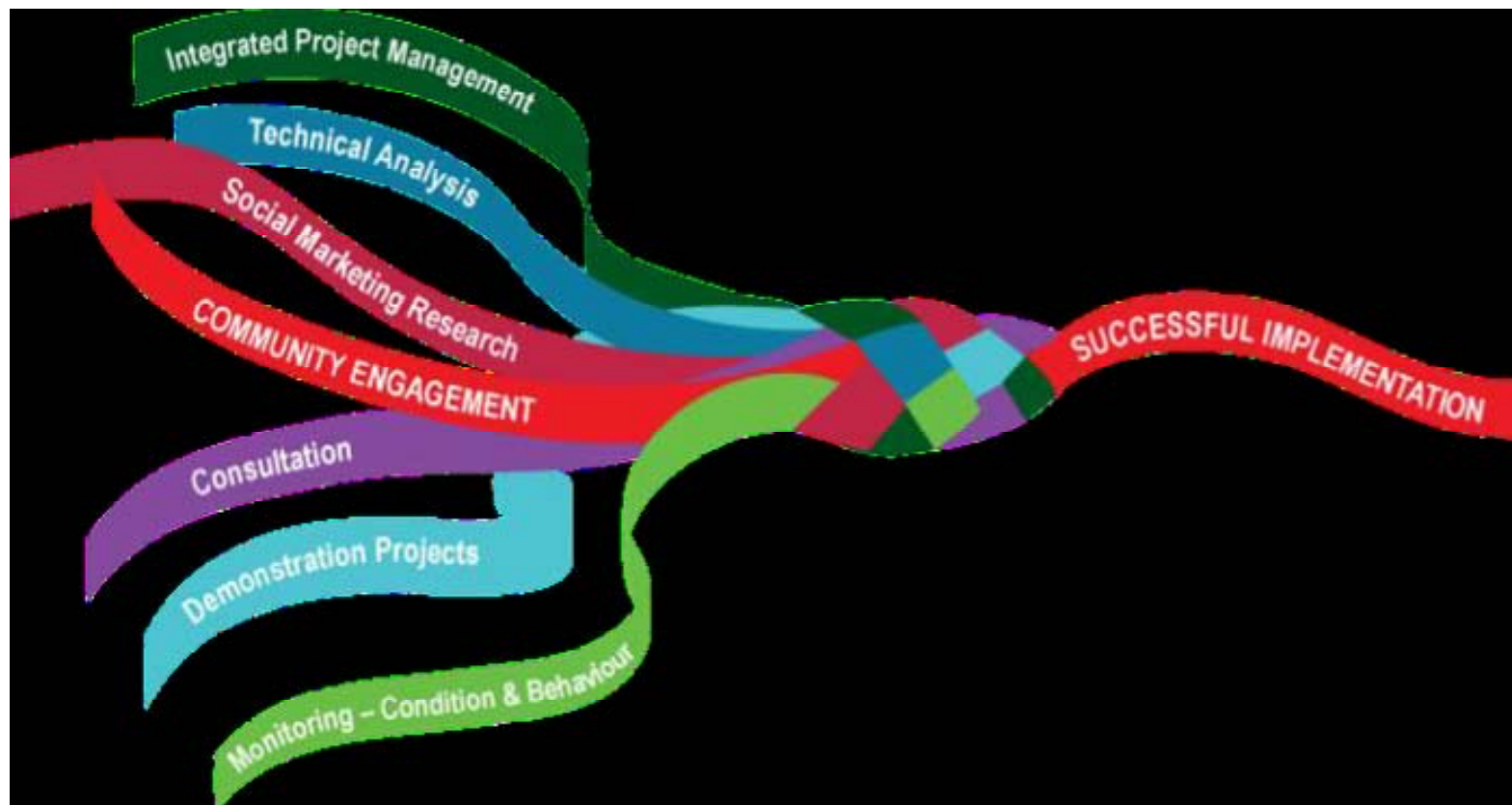
“LID,” or Low Impact Development, is

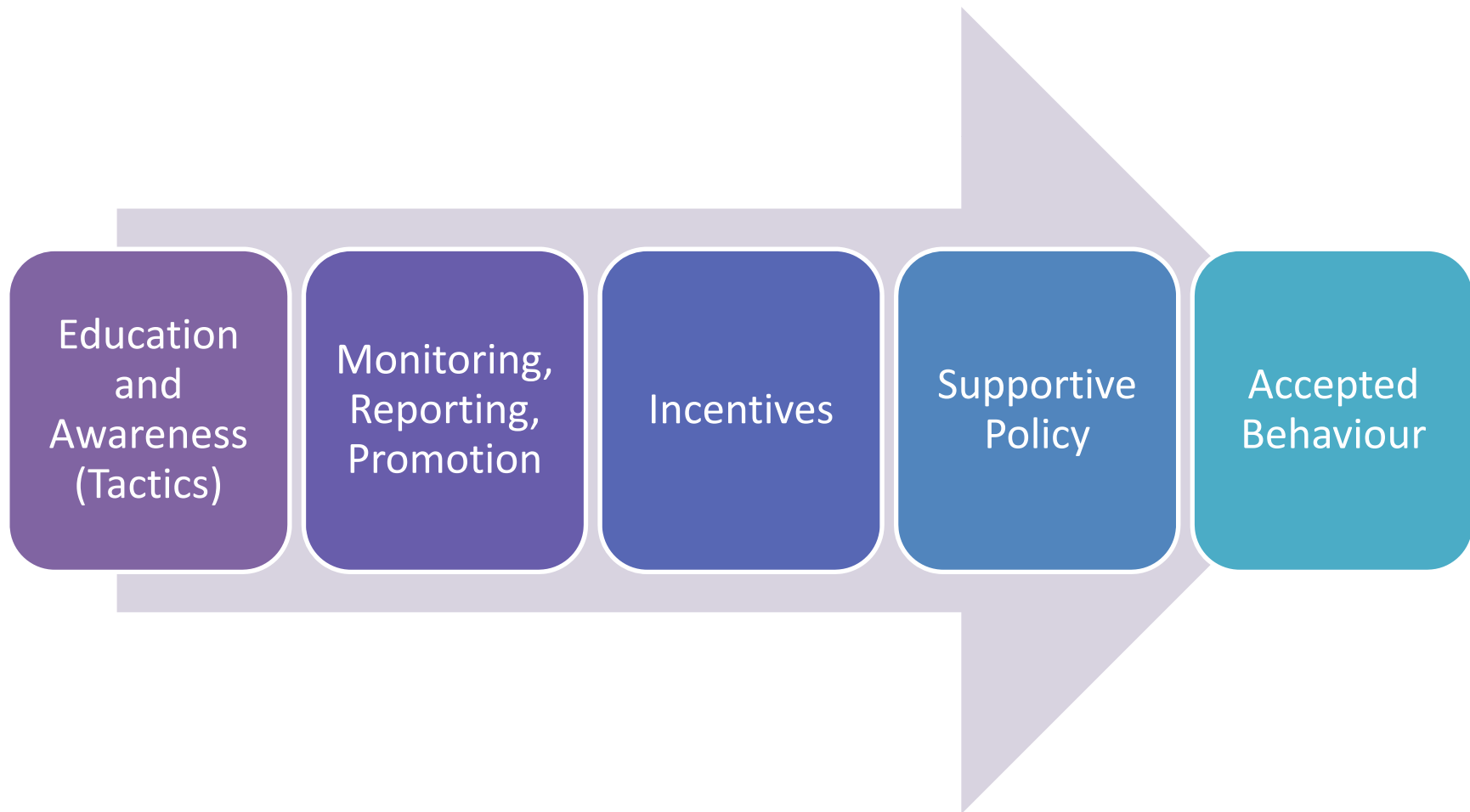
Sustainability Plan
