WETLAND / LOWLAND VEGETATION

1. AQUATIC / OPEN WATER

a. Floating & Submerged Aquatics (Water-shield, Bladderwort)

b. Floating Aquatics (Duckweed, Water-meal)

2. MARSH

a. Robust Emergents (Cattail, Spatterdock)

b. Narrow-leaved Emergents (Lake Sedge, Reed Canary Grass, Purple Loosestrife)

3. BOG

a. Low Shrub (Leatherleaf, Cranberry)

b. Tall Shrub (Highbush Blueberry, Huckleberry, Willow)

c. Treed (Black Spruce, Tamarack)

4. SWAMP

a. Tall Shrub (Glossy Buckthorn, Willow)

b. Tall Shrub (Willow, Dogwood)

c. Conifer-Deciduous (Tamarack, Red Maple, White Birch)

d. Deciduous-Conifer (Silver/Red Maple, Birch, White Pine)

e. Deciduous (White Birch, Silver/Red Maple)

f. Deciduous (Silver/Red Maple, Willow)

g. Deciduous (Silver/Red Maple, Birch, Bur Oak)

UPLAND AND SLOPE VEGETATION

5. FOREST

a. Mesic Slope Deciduous (Red/White Oak, Black Cherry, Sugar Maple)

b. Wet Mesic Slope Deciduous (Black Cherry, White Ash, White Elm)

c. Dry Mesic Upland Deciduous (Sugar Maple, White Ash, Black Cherry, White/Red Oak, Hop-hornbeam)

d. Mesic to Dry Mesic Early Successional Slope Deciduous (Hawthorn, Buckthorn, Grey Dogwood, Tartarian Honeysuckle)

6. SHRUB: Dry Mesic Slope Thicket (Staghorn Sumac, Hawthorn, Grey Dogwood, Buckthorn)
