Re: Submission of Amended Proposed Assessment Report to MOE

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Upper Thames River Source Protection Authority authorize staff to submit the Amended Proposed Assessment Report, and any comments received, to the Ministry of the Environment for approval.

Background

The proposed Assessment Report for the Upper Thames River Source Protection Authority was submitted to the MOE for approval in October 2010. In the Assessment Report a number of data gaps were identified. Since that time the Source Protection Committee and the Source Protection Team have worked towards filling the data gaps and has prepared an amended proposed Assessment Report. The MOE provided directions on changes to be made to the Assessment Report including filling the identified data gaps. The MOE has required submission of an amended Assessment Report by August 8, 2011. As part of the directions we are required to consult with those who are affected by the changes to the Assessment Report. The changes to the Assessment Report include:

- WellHead Protection Area E (WHPA-E) related to the Groundwater Under the Direct Influence of surface water (GUDI) systems
- Completion of the drought scenarios for the Tier 2 Water Budget
- Sewer threats assessment in Perth County
- Updated threats assessment of pasture and outdoor confinement areas
- Various editorial changes including additional details and improved description of work

The Amended Proposed Assessment Report will be posted for review and comment over the month of July. Three open houses are planned during the week of July 25 focusing on the areas where WHPA-E have been added. A few additional letters to significant threats will be required. Most will be sent to municipalities with sewers which have now been identified as significant threats. At their meeting August 12, the Source Protection Committee will consider comments received from the consultation. Following the August 12 meeting the Source Protection Committee will provide MOE with their recommendations on to how to address the comments received. Following the consultation, the SPA is required by the Clean Water Act to submit the Assessment Report and any comments received to the MOE for approval.
