Class Environmental Assessment Continuation

NOTICE OF INTENT

Upper Thames River Conservation Authority (UTRCA), through their consultant Matrix Solutions Inc., is continuing work on the Class Environmental Assessment for the Embroid Dam within the Township of Zorra. The study is the continuation of the 2015 Embroid Dam Class EA. The map below shows the location of the study area.

The UTRCA commissioned a Dam Safety Review (DSR) of the Embroid Dam which was completed in 2007. The DSR identified issues with the spillway capacity and embankment stability of the dam. This Class EA study was initiated to assess the existing site conditions and constraints and develop potential alternatives to address the identified issues at the dam. The project file will be updated to include the recently completed Cultural Heritage Evaluation Report and an addendum to the Existing Conditions Report.

The project will continue under the *Conservation Ontario Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects* document (June 2013).

The Project Team invites public input and comments and will incorporate them into the planning and design of this project. The public will be notified in advance of a Public Information Centre that will be held to present information on the project and receive public feedback.
