

Popular Birding Locations in the Upper Thames River Watershed

Upper Thames River Conservation Authority (UTRCA) staff maintains bird feeding stations at Wildwood and Fanshawe Conservation Areas (CAs). You are welcome to visit these areas during daylight hours to watch the birds. If you would like to feed the birds at our stations yourself, please use black oil sunflower seed only, to avoid any possible allergy concerns for other visitors.

- Wildwood CA bird feeder locations:

 - Forested area behind Campground A playground
 - Please note: Parking is available by the Visitor Services Centre.
- Fanshawe CA bird feeder location:
 - Watson Porter Pavilion
 - Please note: Gates on the roadway by the dam are open Monday to Friday, 8 am - 4 pm, and closed on weekends and holidays.
